Play is a critical part of the social, emotional, cognitive and physical development of every child. Unfortunately, the vast majority of playgrounds deny children with disabilities and critical illnesses the opportunity for exercise, entertainment and social interactions which other children enjoy. In fact, only a small percentage of fully accessible playgrounds exist within our nation and these are insufficient to serve 43 million Americans with disabilities.

An **Accessible Playground** is specifically designed to remove physical and social barriers so ALL children, with and without disabilities and/or critical illnesses, can play side by side with their peers and families.

To be located in Mascoutah, Illinois this playground will be an Unlimited Play accessible playground — a place where limitations will be forgotten and differences are celebrated!

Our mission is to foster an environment where individuals are seen, valued, and celebrated for their potential—without limits or labels. We believe that every person, regardless of their background, abilities, or circumstances, deserves the opportunity to thrive in a space that recognizes their unique contributions and innate worth.
