Why do playgrounds matter?

Play is a critical part of the social, emotional, cognitive and physical development of every child. Unfortunately, the vast majority of playgrounds deny children with disabilities and critical illnesses the opportunity for exercise, entertainment and social interactions which other children enjoy. In fact, only a small percentage of fully accessible playgrounds exist within our nation and these are insufficient to serve 43 million Americans with disabilities.

An **Inclusive Playground** is specifically designed to remove physical and social barriers so ALL children, with and without disabilities and/ or critical illnesses, can play side by side with their peers and families.

To be located in Council Bluffs, Iowa this playground will be an Unlimited Play inclusive playground — a place where limitations will be forgotten and differences are celebrated!

THE VISION

Play Without Limits — For Every Child, Every Family

Imagine a place where every child—regardless of age or ability—can laugh, climb, swing, and explore side by side. A place where siblings can play together, where grandparents can join in the fun, and where families feel truly welcomed. That's the vision for the first fully inclusive and accessible playground in Council Bluffs.

This destination play space will feature:

- An accessible zip line, swings, sensory-rich play areas, and smooth pass-through surfaces so wheelchair users never have to sit on the sidelines.
- An interactive nature trail, inviting children and families to discover, explore, and connect with the outdoors.
- Family-style ADA restrooms with oversized changing tables to meet the needs of all ages.
- A safe, fully fenced environment, giving peace of mind to caregivers while kids run free in play.

In partnership with Council Bluffs Parks & Recreation, HGM Associates, and Unlimited Play, we've already begun shaping the dream. Together, we are creating more than a playground—we're building a gathering place of joy, connection, and belonging.

This will be a one-of-a-kind destination that not only serves our local community, but also draws families from across the region. It will put Council Bluffs on the map as a leader in inclusivity, creating a legacy of play that will last for generations.
